Shepparton Villages was founded in 1968 by the members of the Shepparton Rotary Club and has grown to be the largest residential aged care provider in the Hume Region.

We are a not-for-profit community based organisation that offers a range of high quality residential and community based services.

Shepparton Villages is presided over by an honorary Board of 10 Directors and employs more than 420 full time, part time and casual staff working in three locations:

We currently accommodate more than 350 residents in our Independent Living Units and care for 271 people in our Residential Aged Care facilities. We also care for the elderly in our community through home care packages.
